

FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT OVOC

Okanogan Valley Orchestra and Chorus (OVOC) is a not for profit organization. The mission of Okanogan Valley Orchestra and Chorus is to offer opportunities for anyone to engage in and learn about performing arts. OVOC has been carrying out this mission for more than 40 years. It started with just an orchestra in 1978 and the Chorus was added in 1984. OVOC originally performed in the Okanogan High School gym and after the gym was demolished, we performed in the Omak Cinema. We began performing in the Omak Performing Arts Center (PAC) when it opened in 1990.

The Orchestra consists of 20-40 musicians and the Chorus is composed of 20 -40 vocalists. No auditions are required to join the Chorus. We welcome folks of all ages.

OVOC produces three concerts every year in October, December, and March. This season we will produce a Variety Show in July of 2026. OVOC strives to offer a Broadway style musical in May of each year.

Participating members often travel great distances to rehearse and play, as well as work on our concerts and shows “behind the scenes”. In both concerts and musicals, participating members include adults, children, and high school and college students from Okanogan County and the surrounding region.

OVOC members are all volunteers, which means they give their time and talent for free. Even with that generosity, there is still a substantial cost to produce each concert and musical. Revenue from ticket sales doesn't cover the cost of a concert or a musical performance. To supplement income, OVOC relies on patron donations, sponsorships from local businesses, grants and fundraisers.
