What to Expect

- **30 minute lunch break** - Please bring your own sack lunch as we will have limited time for lunch. We want to honor the time of all those coming out to participate.

How to Prepare - Below are listed the specific audition requirements.

Whether this is your first audition or you are well seasoned, we encourage you to reach out with any questions and one of our production staff will be happy to help you! Do not let uncertainty about what to prepare keep you from auditioning! We are here to help!

- **Song Selection** - Please come prepared to sing 32 bars of a musical theater number that reflects your best vocal range and ability. Please bring a copy of the sheet music for our piano accompanist or your own accompaniment track/recording.
- **British Dialect** - Be working on a British dialect for your reading auditions. Reading materials will be provided at auditions.
- **Clothing** - Make sure to wear comfortable loose fitting that is easy to move around in for choreography purposes. Dance shoes, character shoes, or shoes you feel comfortable dancing in would also be beneficial.
- **Bring Lunch and Water Bottle** - We will have a limited lunch break and it is important to keep yourself hydrated so please bring your own water bottle and something you can eat quickly. **NO** fridge or microwave available.

- ★ **Can I submit a video audition?** *Video auditions will only be accepted if there is a necessary conflict with the audition date and by special request. - ★ **How old must I be to audition?** *We are encouraging families to audition. Ages 5 and up are welcome to audition. However, children under the age of 13 **MUST** be accompanied by an adult at all auditions and rehearsals.*
- ★ **When will I hear back about making the show?** *All those who audition will be contacted 1-3 days after the audition by email or phone call with audition results.*
